

MEDICAL CONSENT FOR A MINOR WITHOUT PARENTAL CONSENT

A minor (under 18 years old) cannot receive medical treatment for themselves without the consent of a parent or guardian, except under the following circumstances:

1. The minor has graduated from high school;
2. The minor has married;
3. The minor is or has been pregnant; or
4. To determine the presence of or to treat pregnancy or venereal disease.

A minor can obtain medical treatment or services to test or treat for pregnancy (except abortion), test and treatment for STDs (including HIV), or receive contraceptive services in a confidential manner without disclosure to anyone, including the Minor's parents or guardian, subject to the Minor's written consent.

An emancipated minor (as declared by a court) may consent to all health services (including abortion).

I hereby attest and authorize that I am a Minor and meet the criteria listed above for the medical treatment without a parent or guardian consent. I permit OB/GYN ASSOCIATES OF ERIE to verify the information for this authorization.
